## First Aid Training Program

The Royal Rehabilitation College is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) located in the grounds of the Royal Rehabilitation Centre, Sydney. Our First Aid trainers are health professionals currently working for the Centre.

### Unit of Competency

This training program is linked to the nationally recognised units of competency:

**HLTFA301B Apply First Aid**  
**HLTFA201A Provide Basic  
Emergency Life Support**  
**HLTCPR201A Perform CPR**



### Program Outline

The college offers a flexible training delivery consisting of an online program followed by a three hour practical session. This approach minimises the amount of time spent in the classroom.

The face to face session consists of practical and assessments. Participants will be required to complete the online assessments and activities prior to the training day.

A log on for the online component will be emailed to participants upon enrolment.

### Fees and Refunds

This training program costs **\$120.00** per person with a maximum class size of 14 participants. This program is GST exempt. There are no separate fees for learning materials or administration.

Discount rates apply for a group of 10 or more to a maximum of 14. This price equates to \$100 per person.

Refunds are payable if a booking is cancelled more than fourteen (14) days before the program. If notice of cancellation is received by Royal Rehabilitation College within fourteen (14) days of the start of the program, refunds are not applicable.

In NSW, legislation dictates that a participant is required to complete a refresher training program for First Aid every three years.

## Outcome of Training Program

Upon successful completion of the training program, participants will be issued a Statement of Attainment identifying the unit of competency HLTF301A that has been attained.
