General Information

The Driving Assessment and Rehabilitation Centre (DARC) provides an important service in helping people affected by injury, disability and/or illness to regain their driving skills, confidence and independence in a safe and supportive environment.

Our program is run by specifically trained and qualified occupational therapists and driving instructors. (see attached profiles for more detail).

Programs are tailored to the needs of each individual to maximise the likelihood of them commencing or returning to driving.

Services include:

- Assessment of the impact of medical conditions on driving skills.
- Assessment of driving behaviour.
- Training in the use of car modifications.
- Ergonomic assessment of a person's driving position.
- Education and training regarding defensive driving techniques.
- Monitoring the impact of degenerative conditions on driving skills.

People can be referred for:

- Initial assessment.
- Driving Retraining by specialist Driving Instructors.
- Reassessments.
- Heavy Vehicle/Forklift Assessments.
- Mobility Scooter Assessment.
- Orthoptist Assessment.
- RTA Disability Test.
