



Prof. Craig Veitch

Prof. Veitch is an experienced epidemiologist and health services researcher with clinical experience in radiation therapy. He is an adjunct professor within the James Cook University of North Queensland School of Medicine, where he was the inaugural Professor of Rural Health and headed the Rural Health Research Unit. He was the Director of the JCU Primary Health Care Research Evaluation and Development Program and was instrumental in developing the medical curriculum at JCU. His other areas of expertise include research into colo-rectal cancer, as well as rural, remote and Indigenous health care and road safety in rural areas. He was appointed Director of the Community Based Health Care Research Unit in 2007.
