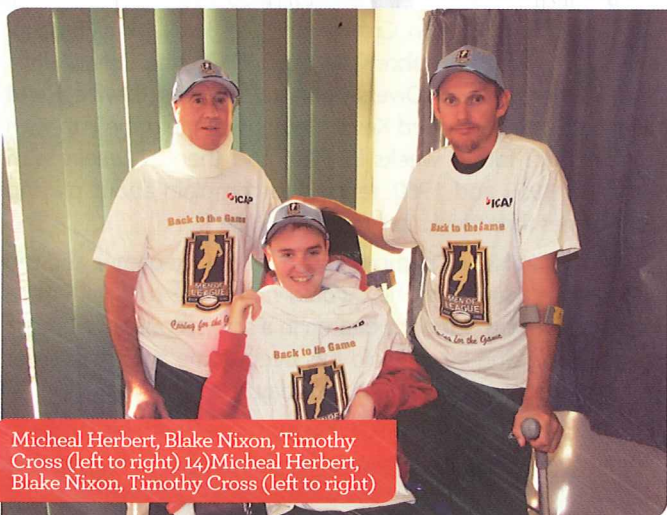


Men of League organised for Ryde Royal Rehab Spinal Unit to watch Sharks upset Bulldogs at ANZ Stadium
