

Weemala works commence today

Construction work on the New Weemala building at the Royal Rehabilitation Centre in Putney is scheduled to commence today (Wednesday).

Royal Rehabilitation Centre Community Relations Officer Jim Towers said soil compaction work by ADCO Constructions has been completed and the company is now ready to build the new Weemala's foundations.

"We have been advised by ADCO Constructions that the works for the installation of the building's concrete piers/footings will now commence this week.

"The drilling rig and the steel frames for the piers/footings will arrive on site this week and the works for the installation of the in ground services including plumbing and electrical work will also commence this week."

In other construction related work, Hunters Hill Council advises that late night roadwork is underway along Ryde Road (opposite St Joseph's College) and delays can be expected for motorists travelling to and from Gladesville.
