7. Research

The Dr Roger Vanderfield Awards encourage the development of Research skills amongst Royal Rehab staff and promote the development of strong evidence-based rehabilitation programs, through sponsorship of research at Royal Rehab. The Foundation raises money to support relevant research conducted by accredited Research entities.

8. Wiihabilitation

The Wii programs are a proven therapeutic tool and exercise routines enhance rehabilitation recovery levels. **\$450** per unit, with hand controls and exercise options. Three complete units are required.
